

Abstract Submission Guidelines

The **National Conference On ET-AIML 2025** invites researchers to submit abstracts for presentation. Please follow these guidelines carefully to ensure your submission meets the required standards. Submissions that do not adhere to the guidelines may be rejected.

1. General Submission Requirements

- **Abstract Length:** Maximum of **300 words** (including title, authors, and affiliations).
- **Font and Formatting:**
 - **Font:** Times New Roman, size 12 pt.
 - **Title:** Use **bold** and a larger font size (e.g., 16 pt) for the title.
 - **Line Spacing:** 1.5 lines
 - **Margins:** 1 inch (2.54 cm) on all sides.
 - **Alignment:** Justified.
 - **Submission of File Format:** Submit as a Word document (.docx).
- **Deadline for Submission of Abstract:** **12.01.2025**
- **Acceptance of Abstract:** **18.01.2025**
- **Submission of full paper:** **20.01.2025**

2. Abstract Structure

Your abstract should include the following sections, organized as described below:

a. Title

The **title** of your research should be concise, descriptive, and clear.

- Use **bold** and **16 pt font size** for the title.
- **Capitalize** the first letter of each major word (Title Case).

b. Author(s) and Affiliations

- List **all authors** of the research work
- Include the **full names** of authors.
- Provide the **institutional affiliation** of each author (e.g., Department of Computer Science, Fakir Mohan University).
- **Mark the presenting author** with an asterisk (*).

c. Abstract Content

- **Introduction (optional):** Provide a brief background of the research, explaining the problem being addressed.

- **Objectives:** Clearly state the primary research question or hypothesis.
- **Methods:** Summarize the approach, methodologies, or techniques used in the research (mention tools or experiments if applicable).
- **Results:** Provide a concise summary of the main findings of the study.
- **Conclusion:** Discuss the implications of your results, potential applications, or future research directions.

d. Keywords

- Provide **3–5 keywords** that best describe your research topic.
- Use **comma separation** between keywords (e.g., "machine learning, data analysis, healthcare, predictive modeling").

e. Acknowledgments (optional)

- If applicable, include any funding sources or contributors that do not meet the authorship criteria.

3. Submission Process

Online Submission: Abstracts must be submitted via the **official ET-AIML Submission Portal** (<https://csconf.fmuniversity.in>)

4. Important Notes

- Ensure that your abstract is free from typographical and grammatical errors.
- Submissions should present original work that has not been previously published or presented at another conference.
- The presenting author must register for the Research Conclave and present the abstract in person.
